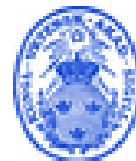
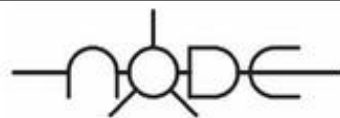

Cosmic dust particles play an important role for the thermal, dynamical and chemical conditions in many astrophysical environments, especially for the star and planet formation process and the late stages of stellar evolution. Dust particles determine the spectral appearance of proto-stars as well as of evolved stars with circumstellar envelopes, and they also dominate extinction curves of galaxies. Announcement: NorWiP exchange lecturers

It is now possible to apply for financial support from Nordic Network for Women in Physics (NorWiP) for exchange of female lecturers for periods of one week.

The host must be an institution situated in a Nordic country or NW Russia. The guest lecturer must as a minimum hold a M.Sc. (or equivalent) degree and have a significant scientific connection to an institution in another of the above mentioned countries/regions.

Support is granted to cover expenses in connection with travel and accommodation. Upper limits for support are:

- Travel: NOK 7000
- Accommodation: NOK 3500

Applications should be send electronically to the NorWiP board as a single pdf-file to norwip_board@nbi.dk; any questions can also be directed to this address. Applications must contain a brief description of the purpose of the visit, a budget, and a short CV (no more than one page) of the exchange lecturer.

The call is open as long as there is funding left, applications will be processed by the board continuously.

NorWiP encourage you to use the **NorWiP database** and/or **the message board** at the NorWiP website to search for a lecturer or for a host. For young researchers this may serve as an opportunity to present themselves to another institution.
